Steps for Acquiring F-1 Visa for International Students

- 1. Apply and be accepted to MINT.
- 2. Fill out the International Student Form and submit to MINT.
- 3. After processing the International Student Form, MINT will send you the I-20 form you need. Check the I-20 Form thoroughly and sign in blue ink.
- 4. Once you have received the I-20 Form, checked, and signed it in blue ink, then, you will need to:
 - a. Schedule an interview appointment at your nearest Consulate or Embassy. (Wait times for interviews vary by location, season, and visa category, so you should apply for your visa early.)
 - b. Fill out, pay, and print the receipt for the I-901 SEVIS Form (<u>www.fmjfee.com</u>). The fee for this form is \$400.00.
 - c. Take a passport style photo to upload onto the DS-160 Form. d. Fill out, pay, and print the receipt for the Visa Application Form DS-160. (https://ceac.state.gov/CEAC/).
- 5. When you go to your interview, make sure that you take:
 - a. The printed receipt of I-901 Form.
 - b. The printed receipt of DS-160 Form.
 - c. Your Valid Passport.
 - d. The printed, signed I-20 Form (sent by MINT).
 - e. Papers and Bank Account Statements that demonstrate you have the amount needed to pay for your studies abroad.
 - f. You may be asked for papers or proof that you have every intention of returning to y our home country following your training.
 - g. You may be asked for Transcripts and Diplomas of your past studies.

Every embassy and consulate are different in what they ask of you; be sure to check the requirements at your local embassy or consulate before arriving for your interview.
